In order for the day to be a success, we ask our parents to participate by sharing their talents with us and volunteering their time. We are asking each volunteer to:

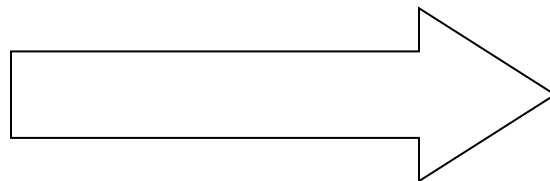
- Participate in a half-day or a full-day of presentations
